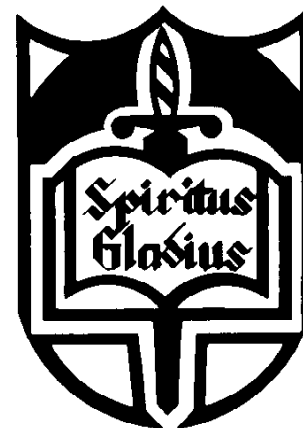
III. Defining Terms

2. How is this *wrong* teaching dangerous to the soul¹:

During that time, all Jews will be converted to Christianity, and everyone else who has rejected Christ will be given an opportunity to repent of their sins and believe in Jesus, thus being saved. —Dispensational Premillennialism, currently the most popular belief about the end times, and the basis of the *Left Behind* fiction series by Tim LaHaye and Jerry Jenkins, the foundation of which was condemned in the 4th C. A.D.

VII. What's the Point?
